EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- Supervise and support work activities of the project staff team.
- Develop Memorandums of Understanding with partner agencies
- Work with project team to establish and coordinate community coalition.
- Assure data collection and reporting requirements of the project are met.
- Collaborate with other YTHC departments to support system development and changes which support the development of a community safer from suicide.
- Provide strong leadership for implementation of Project Venture model for middle school age youth
- Communicate and partner effectively with SAMHSA, SPRC and NPC Research
- Provide ASIST, QPR, and post-prevention trainings in multiple community settings
- Provide leadership to the process of developing a media campaign
- Establish agreements with contractors and oversee their work activities.
- Lead and attend meetings with community and project partners
- Prepare written reports and other project documents required for the cooperative agreement.
- Support the professional development of project staff through regular supervision, and complete performance reviews for non-clinical project staff
- Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's Degree in Social Work, Public Health, or related field
- Demonstrated experience in prevention, youth work, and experiential skills training
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively in a team setting with diverse membership
- Maintain lifestyle consistent with behavioral health role modeling of wellness and recovery
- Knowledge of suicide prevention programs and practices and delivery of behavioral health services to Native American communities
- Must adhere to YTHC policies and procedures regarding alcohol and illegal substances.
- Must possess a valid driver's license to perform job duties that involve driving GSA vehicles both on and off the Umatilla Indian Reservation and maintain insurability to operate a GSA vehicle.
- Represents Yellowhawk with a respected and viable presence in the community.
- Must submit to and pass a reference and criminal background check.
- Must submit to and pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol screening.
