RESOLUTION #04-03-02
**Support for the Northwest Portland Area Indian
Health Board Annual Budget Analysis**

WHEREAS, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB), a tribal organization under P.L. 93-638 that represents forty- three Federally-recognized Indian tribes in Oregon, Washington, and Idaho on health related issues, and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board is dedicated to assisting and promoting the health needs and concerns of Indian people, and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the NPAIHB is to improve the health and quality of life of its member tribes, and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board prepares an annual Budget Analysis on the Indian Health Service (IHS) budget that presents the true funding need for Indian health care programs, and

WHEREAS, the NPAIHB presented this year's analysis, "Priority One: The FY 2005 Indian Health Service Budget Analysis and Recommendations" to the Northwest Tribes at its annual All Tribes budget meeting held on March 4, 2004, and

WHEREAS, Portland Area Tribes provided recommendations to the President's budget request for the IHS that include increases of \$380 million to fund current services and \$228 million to fund an expansion of program services for a total increase to the IHS budget of \$608 million, and

WHEREAS, the Budget Analysis is intended to assist Tribal leaders, health directors and NPAIHB Delegates in assessing the impact that the IHS budget will have in their respective communities, and

WHEREAS, the Budget Analysis is distributed to members of the Administration and Congressional representatives and committees that have responsibility for influencing the IHS budget in hope of advancing the health care concerns of Northwest Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the NPAIHB adopts this year's analysis entitled, "Priority One: The FY 2005 Indian Health Service Budget Analysis and Recommendations", and directs staff to share the information with tribal leaders and delegates in their budget advocacy.
