**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB), a tribal organization founded in 1972, represents forty-two Federally-recognized Indian tribes in Oregon, Washington and Idaho on health related issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the NPAIHB is dedicated to assisting and promoting the health needs and concerns of Indian people; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary goal of the NPAIHB is to improve the health and quality of life of its member tribes, and

**WHEREAS**, cancer is the second leading cause of death among AI/AN; and

**WHEREAS**, since December 1998, NPAIHB has been implementing the Northwest Tribal Cancer Control Project; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the Northwest Tribal Cancer Control Project from the Centers for Disease Control lapsed on November 30, 2002 and has been operating on carry-over funds; and


**WHEREAS**, the Cancer Information Service of the Pacific Region has offered funding to the NPAIHB for its Northwest Tribal Cancer Control Project.


