**Support for the Northwest Portland Area Indian  
Health Board 2007 Legislative Plan**

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB) is a tribal organization that has since 1972 represented forty three Federally-recognized Indian tribes in Oregon, Washington, and Idaho on health related issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board is dedicated to assisting and promoting the health needs and concerns of Indian people; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary goal of the NPAIHB is to improve the health and quality of life of its member tribes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board has proposed a legislative plan which identifies key health care issues facing American Indian and Alaska Native health programs in 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the first session of the 110<sup>th</sup> Congress will take up consideration on many of the issues identified in the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board's 2007 Legislative Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board adopts its 2007 Legislative Plan and directs staff to assist tribal leaders and delegates in their lobbying efforts to implement the plan.


