WHEREAS, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board is dedicated to assisting and promoting the health needs and concerns of Indian people; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the NPAIHB is to improve the health and quality of life of its member Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board has proposed a legislative plan which identifies key issues facing Indian health programs in 2010 and during the second session of the 111th Congress; and

WHEREAS, the 111th Congress will take up consideration of many of the issues identified in the 2010 NPAIHB Legislative Plan, which will also be used by Northwest Tribes, and other Tribes nationally, in their advocacy work on Indian health issues.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board adopts the 2010 NPAIHB Legislation Plan for the Second Session of the 111th Congress and directs staff to assist tribal leaders and delegates in their lobbying efforts to implement the plan.
