Incentive Payments*

(does not include podiatrist, optometrists, dentists)



\$1,462,116.71 to
Portland Area providers
at I/T/U clinics

- 70 providers (24 sites) paid





Potential incentives



93 REC providers have not confirmed payments

Approx \$1.1 million available to be earned just in A/I/U payments (ie, the easy part!)

- 30 providers not yet registered
- 18 not eligible (NP or PA that did not meet patient volume or “leader” status requirements for Medicaid)
- 20 will participate in Medicare program
- Some are pending payment already, some may be eligible for payments for later 2013 or 2014





REC Progress



- Milestone 1: Provider Sign Up
 - 163 providers signed up with NPAIHB REC
 - Target 139
- Milestone 2: Go-Live on an EHR
 - 145 providers live on a certified EHR
 - Target 141
- Milestone 3: 90 Days of MU
 - 43 providers meeting MU
 - Target 80 + to MU by March 31, 2014

Penalty Phase



Medicaid

- None at this time

Medicare

- Starting in 2015
- 1% of Medicare Part B payments
- Up to 5%
- Follows provider





Timeline



- First Year Medicaid 2012
 - 90 days of MU this year
 - Stage 2 certified RPMS EHR delivery Fall 2013
 - 90 days of MU in 2014
 - 365 days of MU in 2015





RPMS Updates



- EHRp11 – installing now
- EHRp12 – Summer 2013
- e-Rx version 2.0 – Summer 2013
- EHRp13 (MU Stage 2 certified EHR) – Fall 2013
 - ICD10
- Personal Health Record (patient portal) Early 2014





Barriers



- E-prescribing for RPMS EHR
 - REC funded drug file optimization at 13 sites
 - 9 sites live
 - 6 more in the queue





Barriers



- **Clinical Summaries Measure** – aka PWH or Patient Wellness Handout
 - Workflow, printers, patient acceptance, length
 - Solution for length – CAC – “how to” document distributed, Area CAC conference call demonstration
 - NPAIHB/NIHB/USET website links
 - Staff available for discussion





Barriers



- Security Risk Analysis
 - Teamed with WIREC (Washington Idaho Regional Extension Center)
 - Onsite risk analysis with written report to follow
 - 23 sites participating
