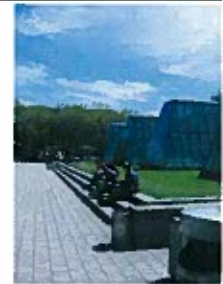
Registration is now open! Enroll today and receive \$300 off our regular tuition.
