Domestic Violence Prevention Initiative (DVPI)**



The Indian Health Service has released funding for the Domestic Violence Prevention Initiative for the 12 AREA offices. Tribal programs, tribal and IHS health facilities may apply for the funding for three categories:

Domestic Violence Prevention Initiative

The purpose of the IHS DVPI is to expand the number of available DV services, advocates and community collaborations available in the Urban American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) populations. The DVPI aims to improve the responsiveness of Urban Indian Organizations by establishing and sustaining programs that prevent violence against AI/AN.

Sexual Assault Projects Expansion Community Developed Models

The purpose of the IHS Sexual Assault Projects Expansion Community Developed Models is to increase and expand the number of available sexual assault services, advocates, and community collaborations available in the Urban AI/AN communities. It aims to improve the responsiveness of Urban Indian Organizations by establishing and sustaining programs that prevent sexual assault against AI/AN.

Sexual Assault Projects Expansion Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner, Sexual Assault Forensic Examinations, and Sexual Assault Response Team (SANE/SAFE/SART)

The Indian Health Service has funding for Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner, Sexual Assault Forensic Examinations and Sexual Assault Response Team (SANE/SAFE/SART) programs for sexual assault for Tribal and IHS Hospitals and clinics that provide 24 hours a day/7 days a week emergency care. The maximum funding for SANE/SAFE/SART is \$250,000.

Check with your local Area for due dates for proposals. Programs must start by August 1, 2010. They will vary by each Area Office.
