Dear Tribal Leader:

For a variety of purposes the Indian Health Service (IHS) annually collects information on Indian healthcare facilities. Last year we pilot tested an initiative to consolidate multiple data calls into a single request. We had hoped that this streamlined process would both improve the information we gathered, and reduce the workload on Tribal staff. We were pleased that the response rate to our request for space certification was the strongest we'd ever received.

Up-to-date information is important for a several reasons. Insufficient data about qualifying healthcare facilities can result in an incorrect share of M&I funds, or disqualification for the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services' IHS Encounter Rate.

It is very important that the Tribe complete the enclosed Combined Space Certification forms for all the buildings occupied by the Tribe's health programs as identified in the scope of work in the Tribe's IHS contract or compact and return them to this office by September 30, 2010. Doing so will ensure that the Tribe receives the proper M&I and Equipment funds, and the Medicaid IHS Encounter Rate for the Tribe's qualifying healthcare facilities and programs.
