Formally known as FAS/FAE (Fetal Alcohol Syndrome/Fetal Alcohol Effect) This workshop will be held on **October 20 & 21, 2010**. The first day will focus on clinical approaches of assisting those affected by FASD. The second day will focus on information for the community. Everyone is invited to attend both days if they feel it would be helpful.

The presenter for this workshop is Carolyn Hartness. Carolyn is Eastern Band Cherokee and Norwegian. As a fetal alcohol spectrum disorders (FASD) consultant and educator, Carolyn works extensively with diverse communities including tribes in the U.S. and Canada, including the Yukon, Hawaii and Alaska and has presented nationally and internationally, traveling as far as New Zealand, Australia and Norway working predominately with tribes and nations.

Carolyn has been a Project Specialist with the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board, identifying issues relating to FASD with tribes in Oregon, Idaho and Washington assisting them in creating models for prevention and intervention since 2000. She works in collaboration with federal, state, local and university programs and offices.

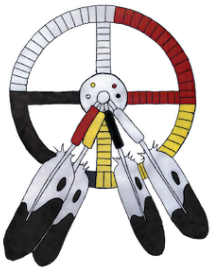

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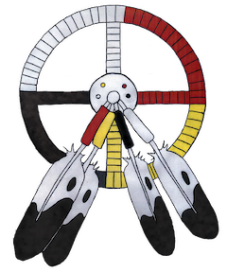

### Wednesday - Day One - Focus - Service Providers

Service providers will be able to assist families in assessing the need for diagnosis of fetal alcohol spectrum disorders (FASD) and how to access the clinic. There will also be a discussion on how to approach families about possible diagnosis. The impact of historical trauma and its impact on clients will be discussed. They will understand behaviors and how to create interventions from a strength-based perspective to better assess the needs of a child affected by alcohol exposure in utero and identify and implement appropriate interventions.

### Thursday - Day Two - Focus - Community

Historical trauma and its impact on the occurrence of FASD will be discussed. Participants will learn the basics of recognizing FASD and understand the importance of structure and consistency for affected children and adults. This will provide them with the necessary tools to improve parenting, treatment plans, educational objectives and case management. They will use "Intervention Mapping," the key elements of appropriate interventions and be able to apply them to what is already working and create other intervention strategies. Participants will understand the need to create interventions that are specific to the abilities and strengths of affected individuals, especially those who are not identified as special needs or children in special education programs but may be struggling with different aspects of their education.
