- Plan injury prevention interventions based on effective public health strategies
- Use data to identify injury patterns and contributing factors
- Present injury prevention proposals to a community audience

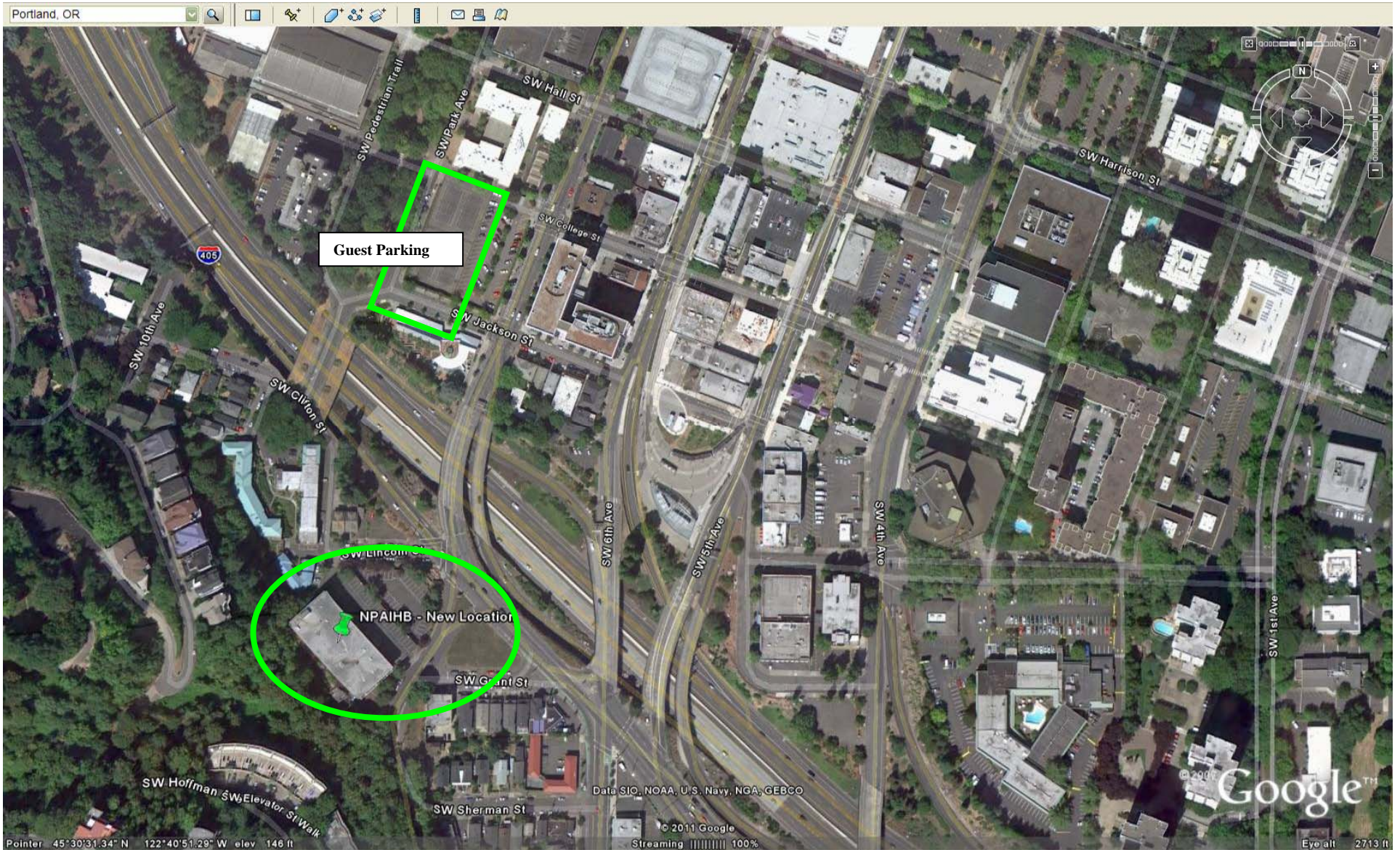

**DIRECTIONS TO SHATTUCK PARKING LOT:**

Coming from I-5 North

- Take exit #302/Beaverton/St Helens onto I-405
- Take exit #1C/6<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Merge into Left lane
- Take Left onto SW Hall St
- Take Left onto SW Broadway
- Drive ½ block to Shattuck Parking Lot (right-hand side)
- (Nearest X-street is SW College) (Nearest landmark is Chiptole's & PSU's Native American Student Center)

Coming from I-5 South

- Take I-5 North towards Portland
- Take Left exit #299B/City Center onto I-405 towards city center
- Take exit #1C/6<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Merge into Left lane
- Take Left onto SW Hall St
- Take Left onto SW Broadway
- Drive ½ block to Shattuck Parking Lot (right-hand side)
- (Nearest X-street is SW College) (Nearest landmark is Chiptole's & PSU's Native American Student Center)

Coming from I-84

- Take I-5 South onto I-405
- Take exit #1C/6<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Merge into Left lane
- Take Left onto SW Hall St
- Take Left onto SW Broadway
- Drive ½ block to Shattuck Parking Lot (right-hand side)
- (Nearest X-street is SW College) (Nearest landmark is Chiptole's & PSU's Native American Student Center)
