NWCPHP is offering a **no-cost pilot coaching series** to help public health agencies that have started the accreditation process and would like additional support from accreditation experts.

The series begins with a general update on current accreditation issues at the **Hot Topics webinar on April 24**. From May through July, participants will then continue the series and receive tailored feedback through:
