Subject: April 25th meeting expanded

In our last meeting, many of you expressed interest in receiving information specific for Oregon's tribes about Coordinated Care Organizations (CCO).

The Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board, on behalf of the nine Oregon tribes and Warm Springs Health and Wellness Center, has submitted a non-binding Letter of Intent to submit a CCO application. To provide technical assistance to the tribes with this application, we are adding an hour to our regularly scheduled meeting on April 25th.

The meeting will be from 10:00 a.m. to noon and will take place in the Hearings Room in the basement of the Agriculture Building, 635 Capitol St. NE, Salem.

At this meeting, technical assistance specific to tribes will be available.
