Dear Tribal Chairs, Tribal Health Directors, and NPAIHB Delegates:

Enclosed are the final fiscal year 2011 user population numbers for Portland Area as determined by the Division of Program Statistics at Indian Health Service (IHS) Headquarters. The numbers show an increase of 910 active users from the previous year. I thank all of you who helped ensure that Portland Area health programs' workload is reflected accurately in the user population figures.

The IHS used the same statistical concept that has been used in prior years to produce the numbers: Unduplicated count by residence, of Indian registrants who have had direct encounters with, or contracted for, IHS inpatient, ambulatory, or dental services during the past three years. User counts are based on registration and encounter data received at the National Patient Information Reporting System (NPIRS) repositories in the standard or simplified HL-7 format.

-Due to the Portland Area's unique situation where most Tribal CHSDA's are in split/shared counties PA distributes UP Based on Tribal Affiliation and Workload

-PAIHS Tribes get their own Tribal Members residing in their own CHSDA

-Unaffiliated Users (Other Tribal Members) residing in split counties are distributed based on workload submission to the National Data Warehouse and then assigned to respective tribes in that shared county evenly.
