Description: This funding opportunity will support 5-year demonstration grants (cooperative agreements) between the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) and Federally-recognized Tribes (or a consortium of Tribes), Tribal Organizations, or Urban Indian Organizations to conduct community needs assessments; develop the infrastructure needed for widespread planning, adopting, implementing, expanding, enhancing, and sustaining of evidence-based maternal, infant, and early childhood home visiting programs; and provide high-quality evidence-based home visiting services to pregnant women and families with young children aged birth to kindergarten entry.
