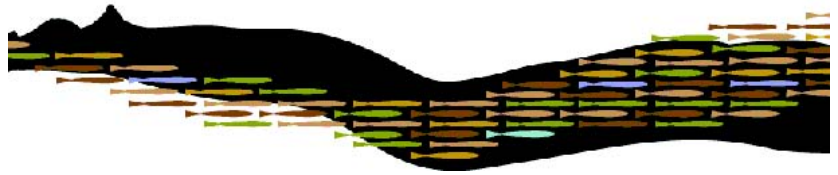


# Save the Date!

The conference will run all day on Friday the 28th, followed by a hosted networking dinner, and then close Saturday just before lunch.
