Why: Tribes will: 1) Review the process for conducting effective QI projects, including development of AIM statements and project measures; 2) Discuss the Rapid Cycle Improvement method and practice several QI tools, such as Fishbone Diagrams and Work Flow Mapping; 3) Review examples of effective QI projects and discuss application; and 4) Discuss concepts for agency-wide QI and several templates for effective QI Plans.

Who: Teams of 3-4 representatives from your Tribal Health Department are encouraged to attend; including individuals with strong knowledge of the department and the public health programs and services.
