The Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB) is a tribal organization established under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (Pub. Law 93-638). Our organization represents the health care issues of forty-three federally-recognized Tribes in the states of Idaho, Oregon, and Washington.¹

We are writing on behalf of our Washington Tribes regarding HB 2466, a bill which is currently before the Community Development, Housing, and Tribal Affairs Committee. HB 2466 authorizes dental health aides and dental health aide therapists in Tribal communities to help to expand the reach and capacity of the dental care workforce in a safe and cost effective manner. This will help to quickly address the deplorable oral health disparities that exist in Washington Tribal communities.

We have included a copy of a letter sent to Committee Chair Appleton and Vice-Chair Sawyer and a document that responds to several of the questions and issues that were raised by Committee Members in the hearing held on Thursday, January 23, 2014. We hope it helps to understand the issues and concerns from the Tribal government perspective.
