Legislative Update

- COVID-19 talks on-going between Representative Pelosi and the White House
- Senator Schumer - introduced the Senate version of HEROES II
 - If the senate flips, we should see HEROES go through early in the 117th
 - Senator Murkowski at NIHB - expect COVID relief in the lame duck session
- Senator Udall spoke about the disparate impact of COVID-19 on Indian Country
- Senators Haaland and Warren are working together on tribal specific legislation for the 117th
