Hazard Mitigation

What is hazard mitigation?

 Hazard mitigation is defined as any <u>sustained action</u> taken to reduce or eliminate <u>long-term risk</u> to human life and property from a hazard event.



Ineligible Activities

- Projects that do not reduce the risk to people, structures, or infrastructure
- Projects that are dependent on another phase of a project
- Projects where actual physical work has already occurred
- Projects constructing new buildings or facilities
- Projects that address operation, deferred or future maintenance, repairs, or replacement
- Studies not directly related to design and implementation of a proposed project
- Preparedness measures and response equipment
- Projects involving land that is contaminated with hazardous waste

Cost Share Requirements

Type Cost Share	Requirement	
Federal Share	Up to 75%	
	(90% for S&I – PDM & FMA)	
Non-Federal Share	At least 25%	
	(10% for S&I – PDM & FMA)	
In-kind Contributions	No cash requirement	
Other Federal Funds	In some cases	
ICC Insurance Benefits	Possible cost share for elevation/acquisition/relocation projects	

Small and Impoverished Status

- Population of under 3,000 people
- 80% or less of the national per capita income
 - National Income= \$29,829.00
 - \$23,863.20 = Must be exactly or under
- Local unemployment rate that exceeds the national rate by at least 1%
 - National rate= 4.1%
 - Must be 5.1% or over


Allowable Federal Funds for Cost Share

- Dept. of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Dept. of Interior (DOI) Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)
- Dept. of Health and Human Indian Health Service Funds

Hazard Mitigation Plans

- Local HM plans are required for **all** projects.
- Projects must link back to the community priorities identified in the plan.
- Local HM plans can be funded with HMA grants.
 - » HMGP funding or PDM funding
