- 9. Establishes relationships with tribal groups, clinical staff and IHS personnel to facilitate appropriate health care provisions.
- 10. Directs dental team at chair side and assists in overall evaluation and management of dental health team efforts.
- 11. Provides prevention, corrective and controls oral health services to patients according to IHS priorities. Prevention services include clinical fluoride program and fluoridation of community water supplies. Corrective services-requiring special knowledge and skills. Control services-recognition of oral cancer and control of infectious oral diseases.
- 12. Conducts an intergrated oral health program with other health services.
