Enclosed please find the worksheet labeled Tribal Retained Shares for Proposed Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board (NPAIHB) Cooperative Agreement. This summary of Area office shares should assist you in the ongoing planning efforts related to the 2016 Planning Cooperative Agreement. I would like to highlight that this is for informational purposes only to illustrate the shares that are still retained at the Area office. If and when a formal proposal is submitted, the Area will prepare an official 106(a) funding amount, based on approved tribal resolutions, confirming which specific line items are to be contracted by NPAIHB.

Please keep in mind the following information when reviewing the spreadsheet:

- 1. Area Office Shares (Page 1) Based on recurring funds, calculation occurs annually when increases are received. The spreadsheet calculations are based on the FY 2016 Portland Area Methodology, updated 6/7/16.
- 2. Direct Service Tribal Area Shares Not available to contract unless the Service Unit and all Federal programs are contracted by the Tribe.
- 3. Residual Amount for those functions that are required by statute (inherently federal) if or when all tribes compact or contract their programs. The amount was developed and finalized as part of a tribal workgroup in 1999. The set-aside amount is a Congressional earmark established to support the Special Diabetes Program for Indians.
- 4. Service Unit Administration (SUA) The amount of funds needed to administer the IHS Direct Service programs as long as those programs are federally operated. If and when the Service Unit functions are contracted by a tribe these funds are released on a proportional basis to all tribes within the Area.
- 5. Non-Recurring Includes funds that are transferred on a non-recurring basis from headquarters to the Area to support health education activities.
- Environmental Health Services (Page 2) These are based on the final amounts calculated for the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering FY 2017 Budget Books.

- 7. Shares related to the Institutional Program (line 62) are not available for contracting under the Direct Service Tribes, unless the Service Unit functions are fully contracted. The amounts support items like infection control and accreditation for Federal Service Units.
- 8. Program Management (line 64) is a proportional calculation of the other three line items (61-63) that have been retained. If all three lines are contracted then 100% of program management is available. If specific lines are retained with the Area the program management line will be adjusted downward in a proportional amount.
- 9. The Environmental Health program also has a defined residual amount for those functions that are required by statute (inherently federal).
