The Division is creating a new rule, OAR 410-123-1265, to provide Medicaid dental providers with parameters for the provision of Teledentistry, use and billing, within the dental program. These rules will align with the Oregon Board of Dentistry ORS 679.543 Use of telehealth by dental care provider and OAR 410-130-0610, Telemedicine.
