

# **Survey Results**

- How often should the coalition meet?
  - Quarterly- 4 times per year (68%)
- In what format should the coalition meet?
  - Mixture of both in-person and conference calls (79.17%)
  - o If there are in-person meetings, have a call-in option
- What do you think the overall goal of the coalition should be?
  - A working coalition that will produce things such as resources, campaigns, or gatherings (58.33%)
