

## ACF security preparation guidelines:

- 1) Obtain local/federal LEO support ( dependent on State/ Federal quarantine or isolation)
  - a. Perform site security survey
  - b. Develop an Operations Plan
    - i. Relay security requirements to Health that are site specific
      1. Provide PPE for LEO guidance by CDC
      2. Review use of force issues
      3. Verify scope of authority
      4. Establish communications systems
        - a. Radios
      5. Fencing/barriers
        - a. Rings of security
        - b. Exercise areas for guests/travelers
        - c. Coordination/communication with wrap around services lead
    - c. Work with Health contractor regarding private security requirements
      - i. PPE fit testing
      - ii. Armed vs less lethal
      - iii. Ability to expand numbers to accommodate Hospital Details
- 2) Integrate Security into the Unified Command
  - a. HHS IMT, CDC, State Reps., Private Medical Contractor or DMAT/HMTF
- 3) Coordinate with the Safety officer for the responding Medical Team
  - a. Participate in evacuation planning
  - b. Routine LEO response and fire response procedures
- 4) Coordinate with other Federal, State and Local law enforcement in the operational area
  - a. Develop procedures for investigation of suspicious activity at the site
  - b. Obtain mechanisms to channel intelligence regarding threats to the operation
  - c. Plan on how to LEOs respond to low to mid- level policing requests at the site
    - i. Allow onsite LEO's to mitigate the immediate threats and allow full investigations to take place after the quarantine period ends
- 5) Work with the CDC or Health quarantining agency to verify proper legal documentation is maintained
