Situation Report: 11/24/20

▶ Vaccine Progress

- ▶ Two COVID-19 vaccines to apply for FDA approval, anticipate mid/late December EUA; planning for distribution - mid/late December
- ▶ Influenza vaccine supplies may be difficult to replenish

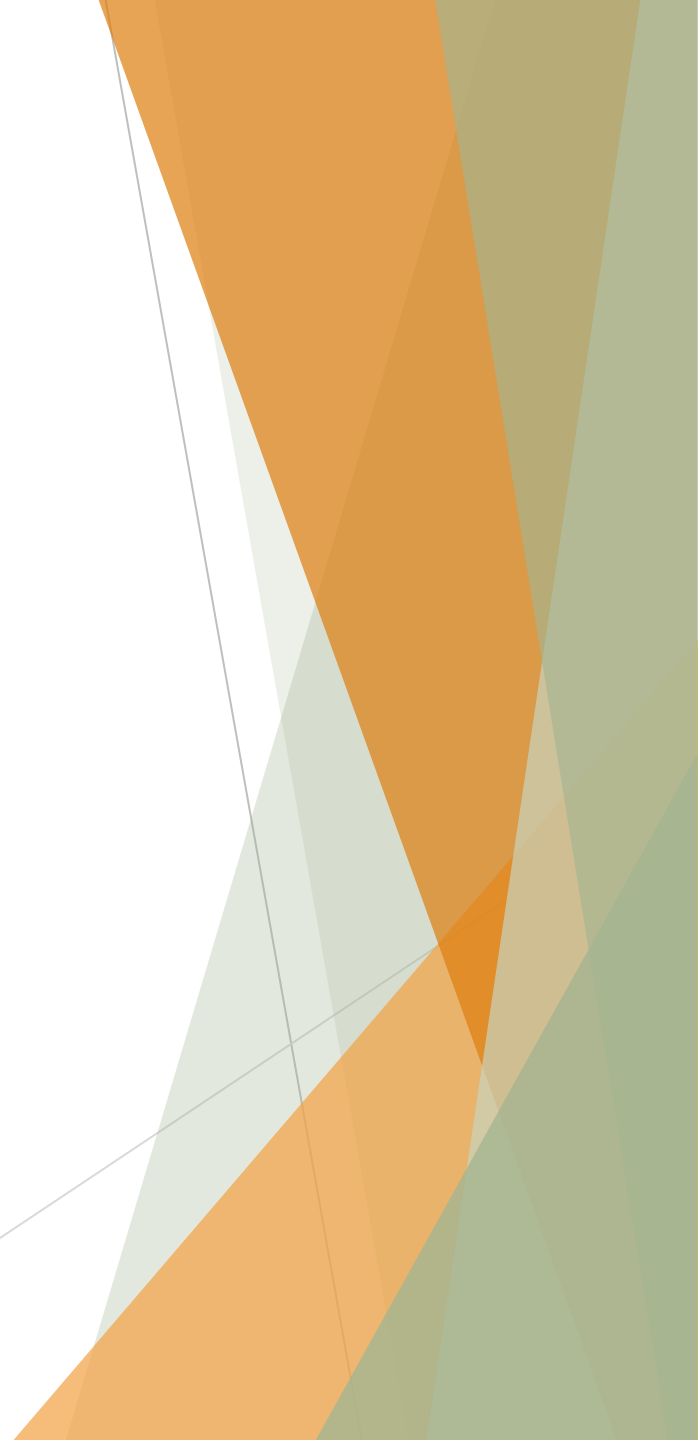

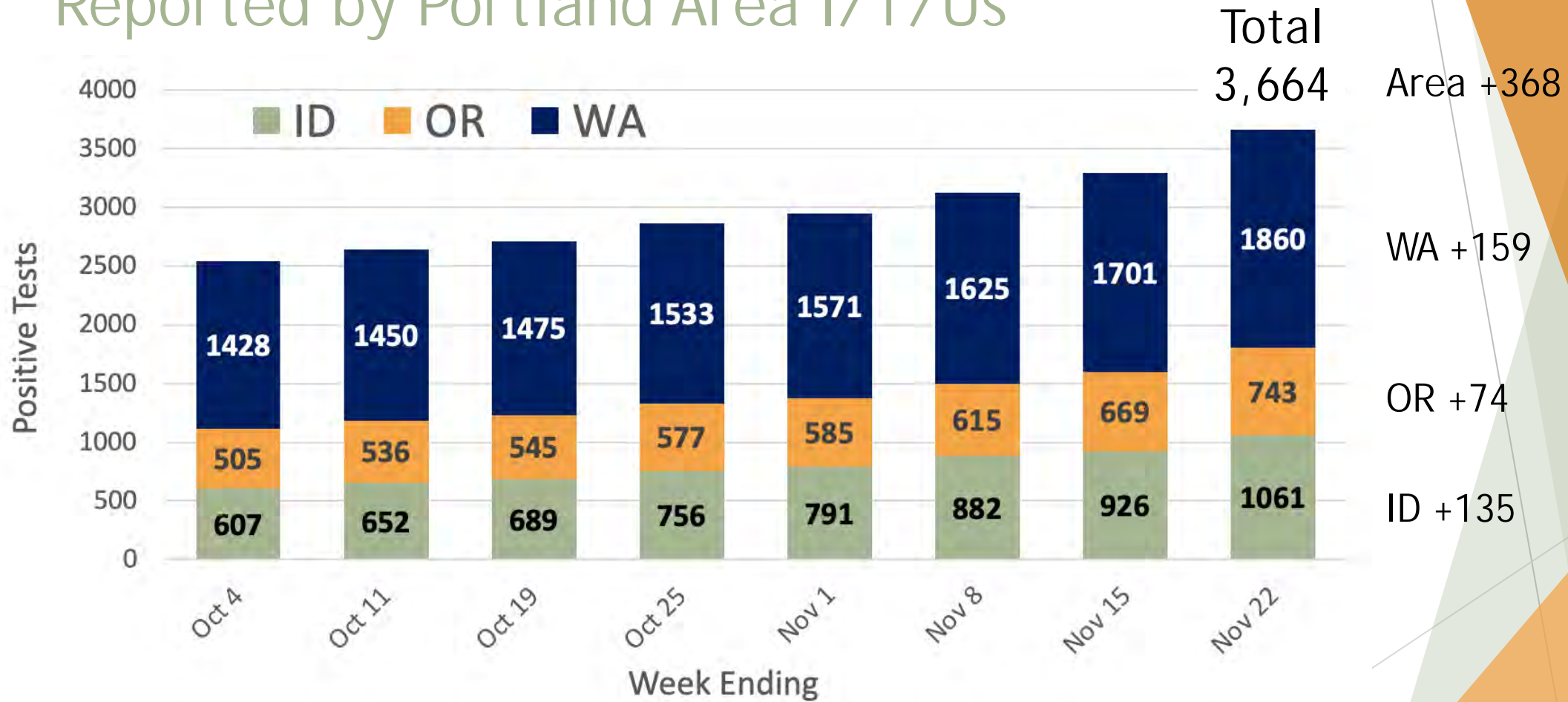

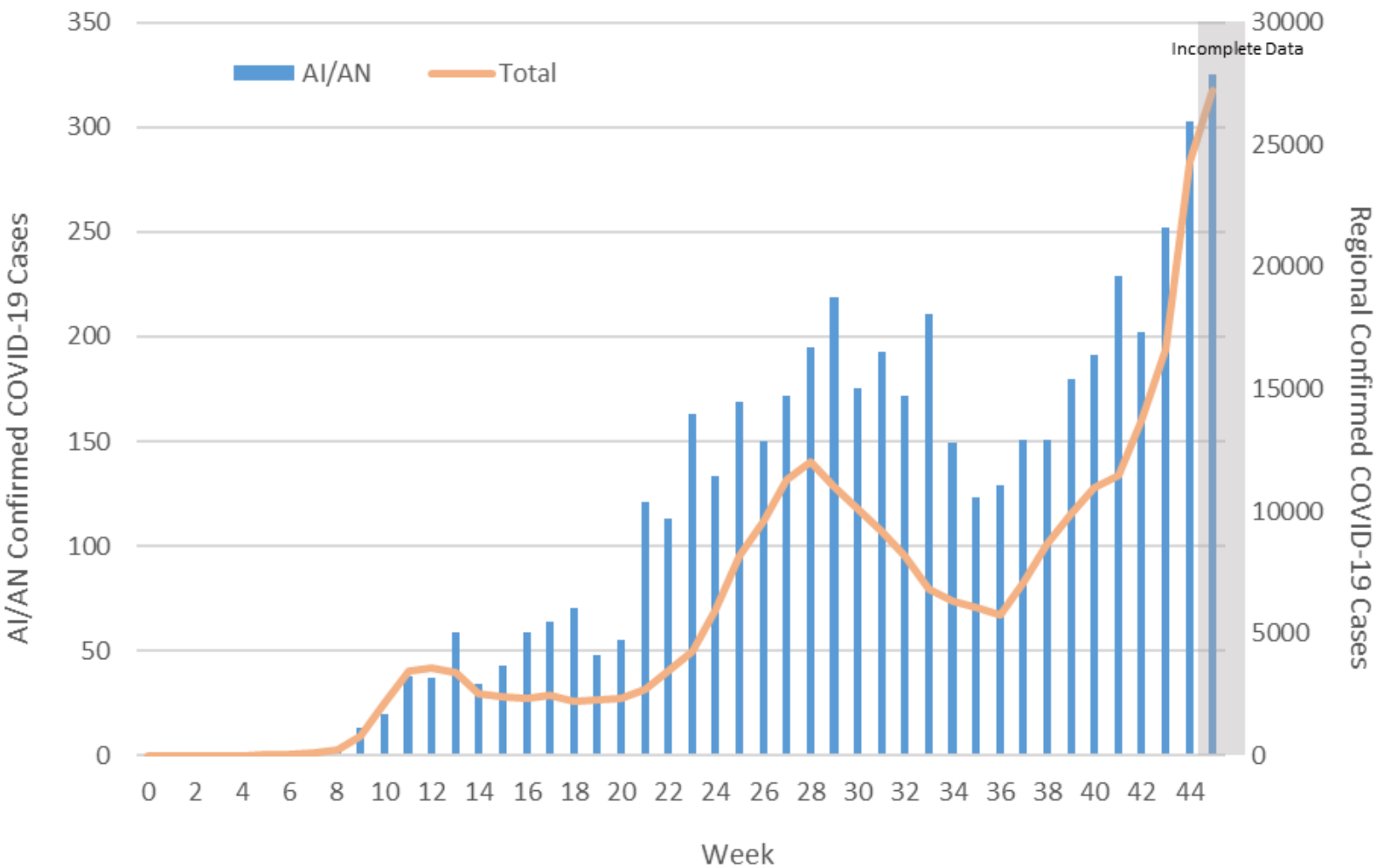
Cumulative COVID-19 Positive Test Results Reported by Portland Area I/T/Us

EpiCurve of COVID-19 Cases by Week



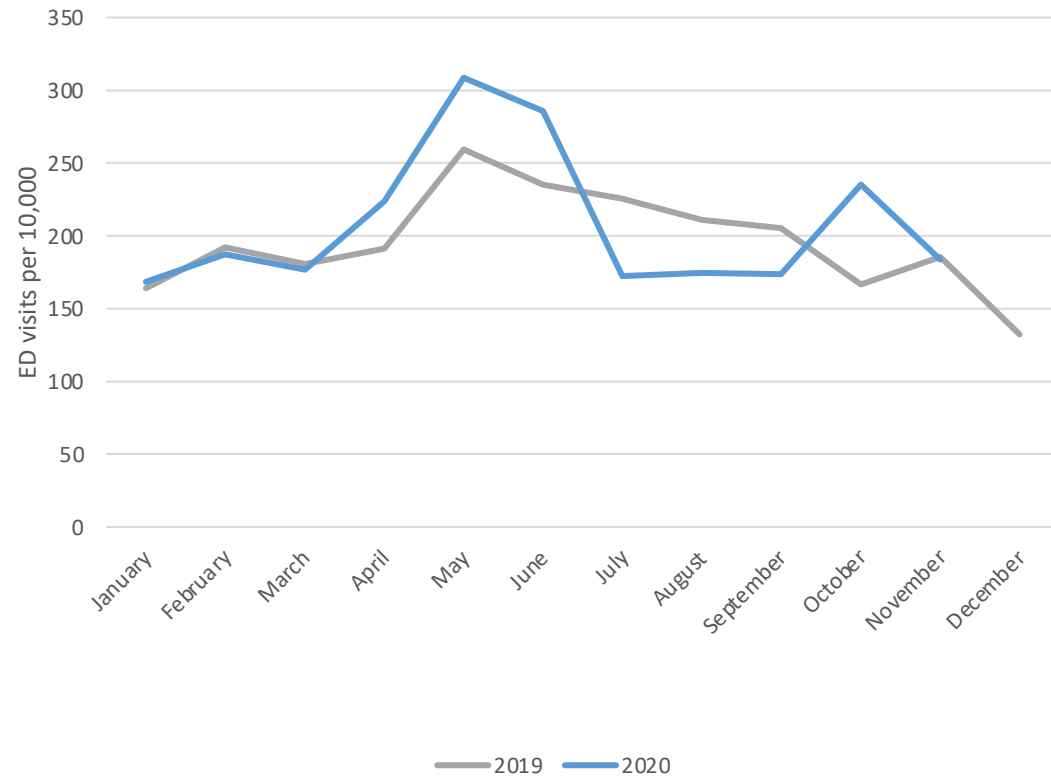

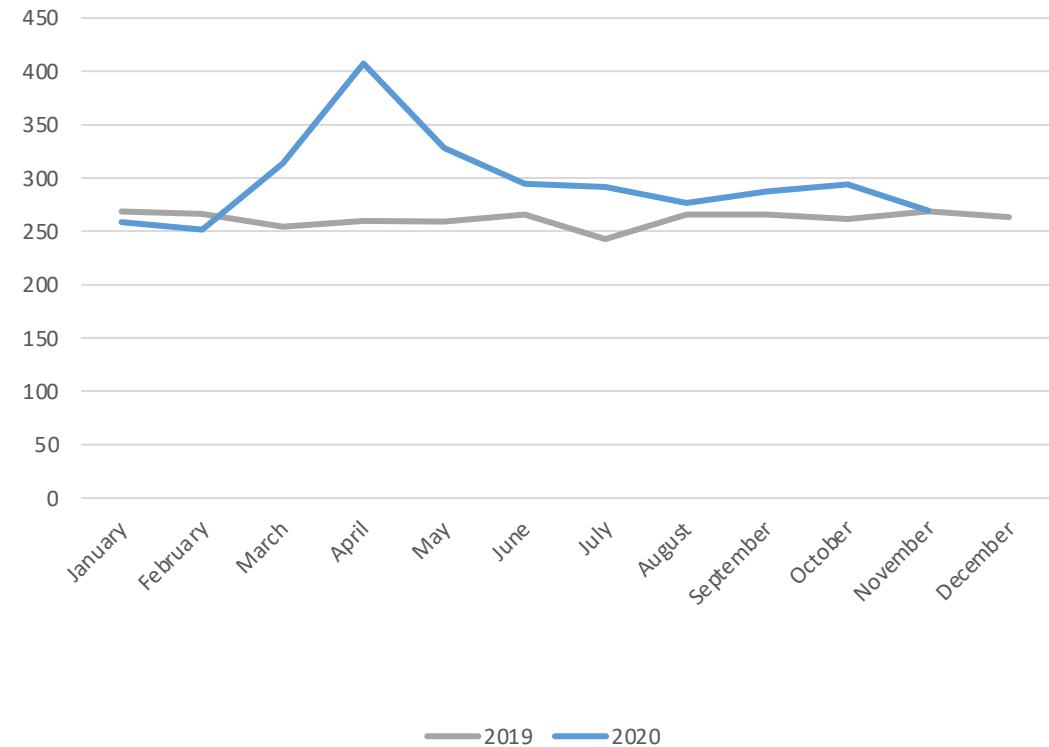

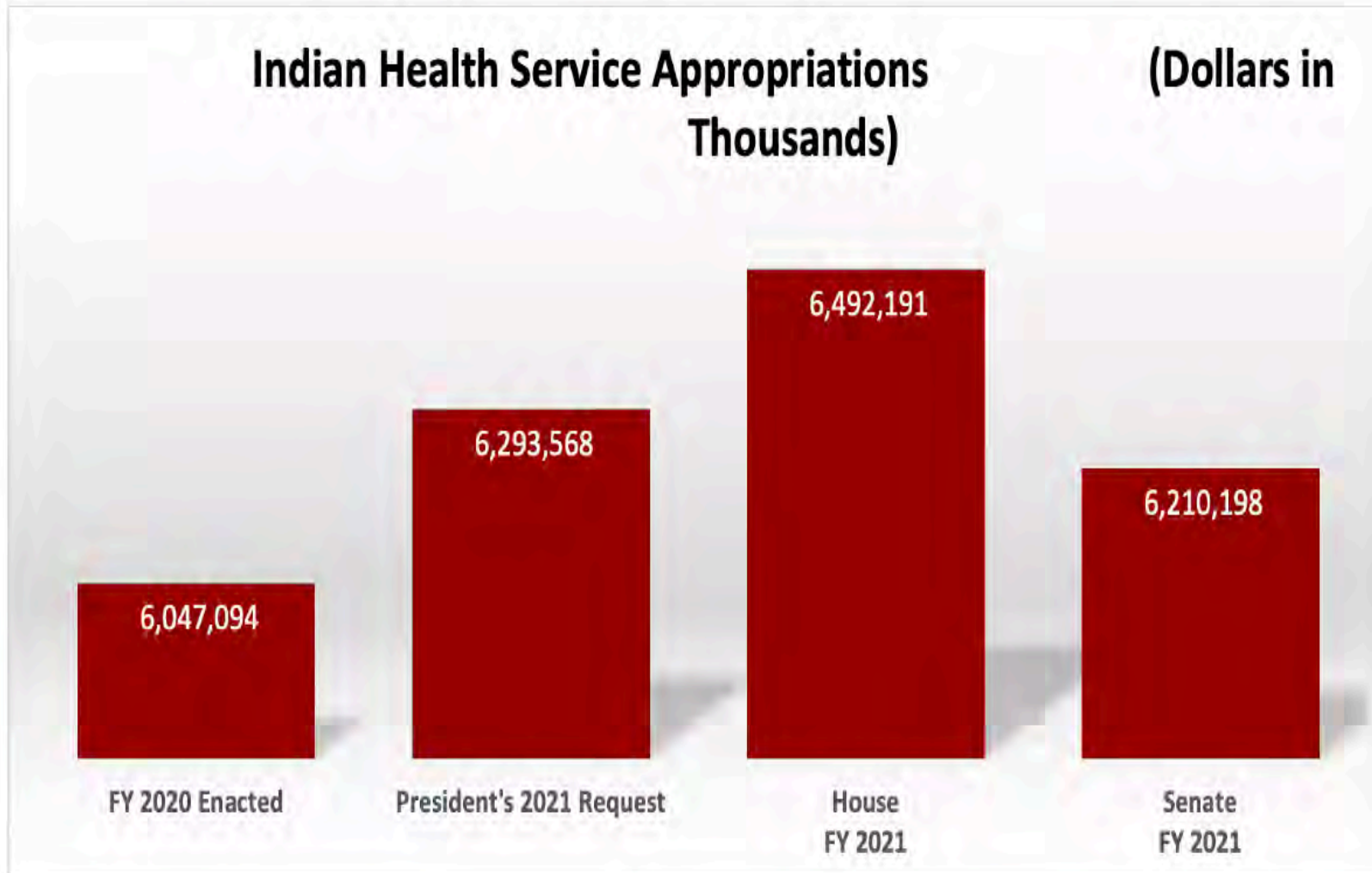

IHS Appropriations in Senate Bill for FY 2021



Legislative & Appropriations Update

FY 2021 Appropriations

- ▶ All 12 Senate appropriations bills released
- ▶ IHS funding at \$6.21b (House at \$6.49b)
 - ▶ Budget reductions in Hospitals & Health Clinics line items \$78m
 - ▶ New indefinite appropriation for Section 105(I) leases \$101m
 - ▶ Senate package does not include House square footage restrictive language
 - ▶ Dental health therapy education of \$2m for Region 10 only
 - ▶ Continued funding for CHAP expansion at \$5m (CHR/Health Ed/CHAP as separate line items)
 - ▶ Does not include \$1.5 billion of emergency funding for IHS and tribal health facilities for construction and renovation that was in House bill
- ▶ HHS Funding
 - ▶ SAMHSA, CDC funding maintained at FY 2020 levels
- ▶ Expect an omnibus appropriations bill with no committee mark-ups; no amendments

Transition Plan Activities Nationally

- ▶ NCAI Transition Plan - presented and worked on by NCAI subcommittees at their recent meeting.
 - ▶ Focuses on first 100 days
 - ▶ Makes recommendations for HHS and IHS
- ▶ NIHB Transition Plan - in process
 - ▶ Ad Hoc National Transition Committee to be convened
 - ▶ Survey to be disseminated
 - ▶ Draft transition plan/document
 - ▶ National Health Transition Summit in mid-December
- ▶ NPAIHB to look at our leg and policy priorities in past years to come up with top recommendations
