For more than 30 years, Tribal Self-Governance has proven to be effective for enhancing the delivery of services to Tribal communities and citizens and has been instrumental in improving Tribal economies and the health and welfare of American Indians and Alaska Natives.

The Self-Governance Communication & Education (SGCE) Tribal Consortium—a non-profit organization that represents more than 370 Tribal Nations that participate in Self-Governance initiatives and assists all 573 Tribal Nations to achieve their own goals of Tribal self-government—hosts an annual Self-Governance conference. This Tribally-led event provides opportunities for Tribal leaders and officials to come together with Federal agencies to learn about leading practices in program administration, build governmental capacity, and to explore opportunities for enhancing Self-Governance.

In 2018, we had more than 900 attendees, including decision-makers and officials from Tribal Nations across the country, federal and state officials, and other interested parties. The 2019 Conference will be held March 31st – April 4th at the Grand Traverse Resort in Michigan. The 2019 conference theme is ***Many Nations, One Goal: Self-Governance***.

Our conference is the only national event focused on furthering and enhancing opportunities for Tribal Nations to further their inherent right of sovereignty through Self-Governance. **Our efforts to expand and enhance Tribal Self-Governance would go even further with you as a sponsor.**
