
COVID-19 pandemic fuels largest continued backslide in vaccinations in three decades

WHO and UNICEF sound the alarm as new data shows global vaccination coverage continued to decline in 2021, with 25 million infants missing out on lifesaving vaccines





Decreased 2 year old Immunization Coverage






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Adolescent Immunization Coverage

HPV initiation among 13 year olds


Tdap coverage among 13 year olds

BUILDING VACCINE CONFIDENCE USING MOTIVATIONAL INTERVIEWING

TECHNIQUES




- **Use open-ended questions** to promote dialogue. Ask about readiness to vaccinate their child and what questions or concerns they may have.
- Paraphrase any information shared to show that you have heard and understood it.
- Praise measures already taken to protect their children, like keeping up-to-date with other vaccinations.
- Then **frame** vaccination as a safe and effective way to help protect them from serious disease.
- Ask for permission to share more information on vaccines.
 This will foster openness and connection.

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Help them make a plan to get their child vaccinated.


Program Goals/Objectives

Learning more about Canoe Journey

- Who can come?
 - The canoe carries the family and each canoe family can decide who they invite
- When is the journey?
 - Host tribes sets the arrival date and then we plan backwards where each canoe joining
- What time do the canoes arrive?
 - Usually in late afternoon depending on weather, currents and how tired. Radio updates are given from support canoe. We are just grateful they arrive safely.
