








### **Non-Invasive Dentistry flow chart**




### NTDSC and Arcora: Dental Data Dashboard

# Supports clinics to utilize aggregate data to monitor:

- □ Access to care
  - User population
  - Kept appointments
- Disease/health
  - Treatment completed
- □ Preventive care
  - **Fluoride**
  - **G** Sealants
- Additional metrics possible
  - (future phases)






### Why Data and a Dashboard?

- > Allows you to manage basic dental measures and provide you the opportunity to further evaluate your dental program. In general, it provides a tool for goal setting and planning.
- > Dental metrics (aggregate data) allow each program to monitor their own progress and evaluate for improvement.
- > The dashboard will not only allow you to follow your own clinic's data trends but will also allow you to compare your program with the aggregated data from our area.
- > Clinics will have the needed information to plan Quality Assurance and/or Quality Improvement projects that are meaningful. This will assist you in meeting certain accreditation (AAAHC) requirements.
