- Youth earn up to **\$2,000** for research-related costs

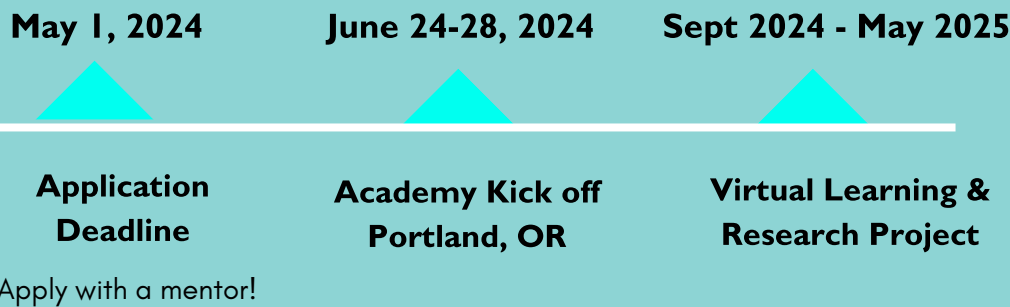
ELIGIBILITY
