



Advancing Tribal Public Health Through Data Modernization



Two opportunities to support data modernization


- 1. Public Health Infrastructure Grant Tribal Implementation Center
 - The goal of the program is to improve the timely prevention and detection of public health threats by reducing the burden of data exchange between public health agencies, healthcare systems, and the communities they serve.
 - Anticipated funding: +/- \$600,000-\$800,000 (total award) through Fall 2027.
 - Application open September 8, 2025 (awarded on a rolling basis).
- 2. CDC Foundation Workforce Acceleration Initiative (WAI)
 - The goal of WAI is to strengthen public health agencies'/authorities' (PHA) capacity to deliver information system improvements that are of top priority to each PHA by adding technology and data experts to their teams.
 - WAI will place 1-4 technology and data experts in selected PHAs through June 2027.
 - Applications due October 17, 2025.



What is data modernization?

Data modernization seeks to move our current siloed infrastructure to a more connected data ecosystem that informs public health decisions, actions, and services.

Public health agencies across the country are developing and implementing data modernization strategies to upgrade old systems, incorporate automated processes, and enhance workforce skills.
