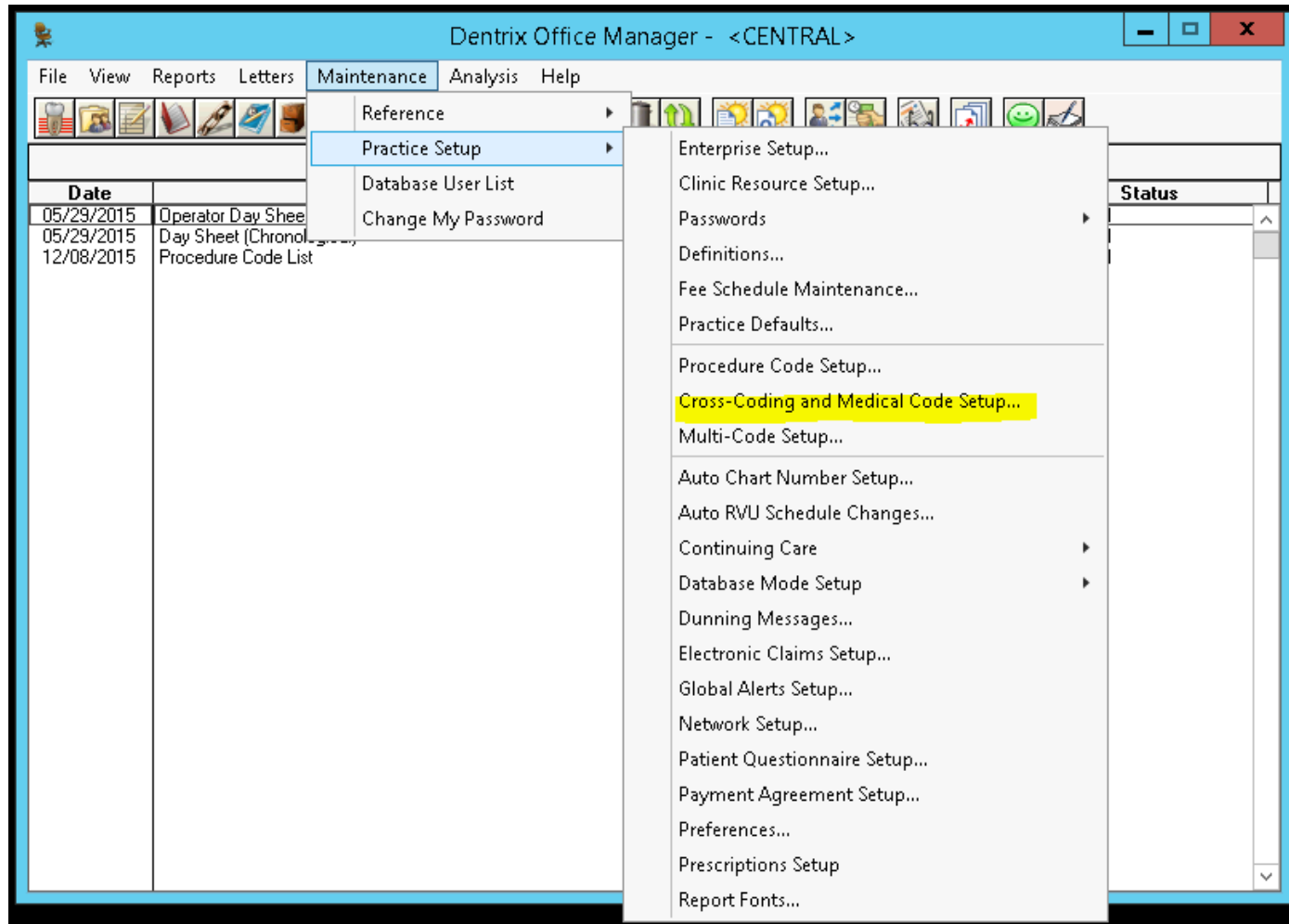

Once you treatment plan a procedure, you can double-click on the treatment line and you will see that the diagnosis is already entered because the Z01.21 code was selected as the default code. You can change this by clicking on **Diagnoses:** >>

Points to Ponder

- ▶ You can directly complete procedures that have default ICD-10 codes.
- ▶ You must treatment plan procedures that do not have default codes and then add the ICD-10 code prior to completing the procedure.
- ▶ Communicate with your coder regarding this process change, they may have some more tips to make your life easier.
- ▶ If you select no ICD-10 code, ZZZ.999 is the default.
- ▶ **Please remember that you cannot modify a **Completed** procedure, you must delete the procedure and add a new procedure.**
